raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam.

Timber, pinon and juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush.

N. 0° 07' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over heavily rolling mountainous land, through medium heavy timber and undergrowth; asc. 250 ft. over S. slope.

22.00 Spur, slopes SSW.; continue along W. slope.

29.00 Continue ascent; asc. 80 ft. over S. slope.

39.94 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance. There is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Continue measurement over rolling land; asc. 40 ft. over S. slope.

46.80 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 90 ft. over NE. slope.

53.10 Bottom of descent; begin ascent; asc. 50 ft. over SE. slope.

64.40 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.

79.88 The corner of Tps. 11 and 12 N., Rs. 64 and 65 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the south boundary of T. 12 N., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same group.

Land, rolling mountainous.

Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam.

Timber, pinon and juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush.
