CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land along the boundaries of T. 11 N., R. 64 E. is gently rolling and rolling mountainous land.

The elevation ranges from about 6,500 ft. in the valley to about 8,100 feet above sea level in the eastern portion of the township. The soil varies from sandy clay loam in the valley lands to gravelly and rocky on the mountains.

The timber is composed of medium heavy growth of pinon and juniper with a moderately heavy growth of mahogany at the higher elevations.

The eastern portion of the township drains in a northerly direction into Steptoe Valley and the western portion drains southerly into Cave Valley.

There is a sparse growth of native grasses along the water courses and principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by semi-improved roads.
