CHAINS

Land, rolling.
Soil, sandy clay and stony.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and bunchgrass.

N. 0° 07' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 24.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 150 ft. over a S. slope.

38.99 The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 19, T. 17 N., R. 32 E., only; hereinafter described.

40.07 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, monumented with a lava stone, 14x12x10 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 24, T. 17 N., R. 31 E., only.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. for the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, T. 17 N., R. 31 E., only.
