	Over nearly level land, along N. edge of desert road, bearing generally E. and W.	
29.70	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains N.	
30.57	The N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 2, T. 20 N., R. 34 E., hereinafter described.	
40.00	Point for the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 35, at a proportionate distance; the original 1928 cor. monument was found removed by a road grader.	
	Bury the original cor. monument, an iron post, 1 in. in diam., 36 ins. long, 12 ins. below surface of ground, and add "1965" to original marking.

	The center of a water well casing 16 ins. in diam., bears N. $67\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 107.6 ft. distance.	
	An iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set 22 ins. in the ground, in a collar of stone to cap, for a reference monument, bears N. $3/4^{\circ}$ W., 50.0 ft. distance, with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 RM 50.0 ft. 1965, with an arrow pointing to the true corner.	
70.56	The closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 20 N., R. 34 E., hereinafter described.	
80.00	The standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd., and witnessed as described in the official records.	
	Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.

	From the cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 34 and 35 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd., and witnessed as described in official records.

	C.&G.S. triangulation station "HORSE" monumented with a brass tablet set flush in a granite boulder, 4 ft. long, 3 ft. wide, exposed 1 ft. above the ground, bears S. $68^{\circ} 45'$ E., 96.64 chs. dist.	
	NORTH, bet. secs. 31 and 36.	
	Over gradual NW. slope, through medium undergrowth.	
12.60	Wash, drains NW., irregularly.	
23.50	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NW.	
31.40	Wash, 1.00 ch. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains NW.	
40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36.
