

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, FIFTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH, R. 60 E.

CHAINS

N. 89° 53' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over low mountainous land, through scattered juniper.

1.30 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SE.; asc. 200 ft. over a broken E. slope.

40.30 Point for the standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 30½° E., 20 lks. dist., mkd. ½ S 31 SC BT.

A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 55 3/4° W., 21 lks. dist., mkd. ½ S 31 SC BT.

Asc. 40 ft. over an E. slope.

46.00 Ridge, bears N. and SE.; desc. 80 ft. over a W. slope.

53.00 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NW.; desc. 30 ft. along a N. slope.

61.70 Bottom of draw, drains NNE.; asc. 20 ft. over a SE. slope.

64.00 Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.; asc. 60 ft. over a SE. slope.

80.60 The Standard Tp. Cor. of T. 26 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E., monumented with a squared wooden post, 12 x 2 x 2 ins., badly deteriorated and set in a small circle of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
