

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, EAST BDY. OF T. 26 N., R. 60 E.

CHAINS

- 55.00 Ridge, bears irregularly S. and NW.; desc. 110 over a broken N. slope.
- 65.00 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NE.; asc. 40 ft. over a gentle S. slope.
- 75.00 Spur, slopes ENE.; desc. 40 ft. along an E. slope.
- 80.47 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 32° E., 10 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R61E S 7 BT.

A juniper, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 36½° W., 119 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R60E S 12 BT.

A pinon, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 46° W., 26 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R60E S 1 BT.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, sandy clay and gravelly.  
Timber, medium dense juniper and pinon.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush and bitterbrush.

N. 0° 04' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over rolling mountainous land through medium dense timber; asc. 30 ft. along an E. slope.

- 22.00 Spur, slopes ENE.; desc. 80 ft. over a N. slope.

- 40.23 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
