A juniper, 10 ins. diam., bears S. $72\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 21 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R60E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 BT.

Desc. 10 ft. over a N. slope.

48.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains NE.; desc. 30 ft. over rolling land.

65.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains ENE.

74.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 12 ins. deep, drains ENE.

80.47 The cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., monumented with a wooden post 12 x 2 x 2 ins. and loosely set in a small circle of stones.
