- 71.70 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains E.
- 80.72 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
