CHAINS

Land, rolling.
Soil, sandy clay and rocky.
Timber, scattered juniper.
Undergrowth, scant sagebrush.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

N. 0° 16' E., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over rolling land, through scattered timber; desc.
50 ft. over a N. slope.

12.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.; asc. 80
ft. over a S. slope.

19.60 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 50 ft. over a N. slope.

39.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.

40.33 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of
the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
