GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 10 North, Range 57 East, is about 5300 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level land. The soil is sandy clay. There is bunch grass along the drainages. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and greasewood.

The township is drained S., by two main washes, in the west side of the township. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

The U.S. Highway No. 6, crosses the southeast portion of the township in a NE. and SW. direction.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by desert roads.
