From the standard cor. of T. 11 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E.,  
monumented with a squared wooden post, firmly set and  
marked as described in the official record.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in  
the ground, with brass cap mkd.
