

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE E. BDY., T. 11 N., R. 56 E.

CHAINS	
	N. 0° 14' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.
	Over gently rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.
16.50	Trail road, bears E. and W.
36.34	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 11 N., R. 57 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., hereinafter described.
38.00	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.
39.96	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a squared wooden post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. square, firmly set and marked as described in the official record. This corner will now function as the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 11 N., R. 56 E., only.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
	<p>T11N R56E R57E $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 1 1965</p>
	reset the wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
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	N. 0° 12' W., beginning new measurement.
	Over gently rolling land.
11.20	Graded road, bears E. and W.
21.00	Graded road, bears NE. and SW.
29.42	The closing cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., R. 57 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., hereinafter described.
32.50	Old Highway No. 20, gravel, bears NW. and SE.
40.43	The cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., Rs. 56 and 57 E., monumented with a squared wooden post, 36 ins. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set and marked as described in the official record. This corner will now function as the cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., R. 56 E.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
