40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

78.80 Abandoned Nevada State Highway No. 20, gravel, bears NW. and SE.

82.16 Intersect E. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 11 N., R. 56 E.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., R. 57 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
