The cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 13 N., R. 57 E., bears EAST, 5.69 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

The ¼ sec. cor. on the S. bdy. of sec. 33, T. 13 N., R. 57 E., bears WEST, 34.31 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

The point for the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 3 is on the S. bdy. of T. 13 N., R. 57 E. and at midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 3.
