## CHAINS

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

S. 89° 58' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

40.41 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

S. 89° 07' W., beginning new measurement.

35.99 The cor. of Tps. 33 and 34 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

N. 0° 16' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over mountainous terrain, through scattered brush; desc. 20 ft. over gentle N. slope.

2.40 Dun Glen Road, improved gravel, bears E. and W.; asc. 70 ft. over gentle SW. slope.

24.80 Small drainage, drains SW.; asc. 80 ft. over gently rolling SW. slope.

35.60 Low spur, slopes ESE.; desc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.

39.50 Swale, drains ESE.; asc. 10 ft. over SSW. slope.

40.28 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with a slate stone, 20x7x5 ins., firmly set in a collar of stone and dimly mkd. as described in the official record.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 4 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
