At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

10.70 Western Pacific Railroad, bears N. 52½° E. and S. 52½° W.

11.50 Telephone line, bears N. 52½° E. and S. 52½° W.

40.11 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
