	<p>Land, rolling Soil, sandy and gravelly. Undergrowth, shadscale.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 36 N., R. 38 E., executed under this same group.</p>
	<p>N. 89° 52' W., bet. secs. 24 and 25.</p>
	<p>Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.</p>
21.10	<p>Gravel road, bears SE. and NW.</p>
23.80	<p>Trail road, bears SE. and NW.</p>
39.98	<p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, monumented with a wooden post, 5x5x60 ins. long, plainly scribed ¼ on the S. face and firmly set in the ground. This position has long been recognized as the cor. by adjacent landowners and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.</p>
	<p>At the corner point</p>
	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>

	<p>reset the wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.</p>

	<p>Over gently rolling land.</p>
4.00	<p>Wash, 20 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains S.</p>
15.60	<p>Trail road, bears irregularly N. and S.</p>
37.00	<p>Trail road, winding E. and W.</p>
38.79	<p>The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.</p>
	<p>Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy and gravelly. Undergrowth, shadscale.</p>
	<p>N. 4° 21' W., bet. secs. 23 and 24.</p>
	<p>Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 610 ft. over SSE. slope to the ¼ sec. cor.</p>
