

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY, T. 36 N., R. 37 E.

## CHAINS

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, sandy clay and rocky.  
Undergrowth, June grass and sagebrush.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18 on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 36 N., R. 38 E., executed under this same group.

N. 89° 52' W., bet. secs. 12 and 13.

Over mountainous land, through medium undergrowth.

- 2.80 Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 300 ft. over E. slope.
- 17.40 Spur, slopes SE.
- 18.90 Power line, bears SE. and NW.
- 25.50 Telephone line, bears SE. and NW.
- 27.20 Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 490 ft. over E. slope.
- 36.80 Spur, slopes SE.; asc. 100 ft. over SE. slope.
- 41.01 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., over a cross (X) on bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4½ ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.
