

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, T. 34 N., R. 38 E.

CHAINS

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

N. $0^{\circ} 12'$ E., beginning new measurement.

Desc. 50 ft. over a steep broken W. slope.

13.90 Ravine, drains SW.; willows and chokecherry along bottom. Asc. 480 ft. over a SE. slope, through scattered juniper and pine.

34.00 Spur, slopes ESE.; desc. 40 ft. along an ENE. slope.

40.42 The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, on the S. bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 38 E., monumented with a limestone, 16 x 8 x 5 ins., firmly set and plainly mkd. as described in the official record.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.
