	<p style="text-align: center;">T34N R38E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 S 2 1965</p> <p>bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post.</p> <hr style="width: 20%; margin: 10px auto;"/> <p>N. 1° 04' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over mountainous land.</p>
0.80	Small ravine, drains SSE.; asc. 160 ft. over a rolling S. slope; through dense chokecherry.
10.30	Spur, slopes SSE., leave chokecherry; asc. 480 ft. over a rolling SE. slope.
38.90	Crest of spur, slopes SSW. from N.; asc. 10 ft. along a W. slope.
40.80	The original closing corner of secs. 2 and 3, monumented with a granite stone, 15 x 12 x 8 ins., firmly set in a collar of stone and plainly mkd. as described in the official record. I mark the corner stone with an ' X ' and the letters AM, and rehabilitate the collar of stone.
42.49	Intersect the S. bdy. of sec. 34, T. 35 N., R. 38 E. Point for the closing corner of secs. 2 and 3. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 5 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.
