	Asc. 100 ft. over a S. slope, through scattered juniper.
46.50	Low rocky spur, slopes SE.; desc. 80 ft. over a N. slope.
50.30	Mullen Canyon, drains SE.; asc. 20 ft. over a SW. slope.
54.00	Low spur, slopes W.; desc. 10 ft. over a NW. slope.
58.00	Mullen Canyon, drains SW.; asc. 80 ft. over a SE. slope.
62.00	Limestone ledge, 10 ft. high, bears SE. and NW.; desc. 20 ft. over a NE. slope.
63.10	Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 550 ft. over a SSW. slope.
82.07	Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 38 E.
	Point for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 5 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.
