

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, T. 34 N., R. 38 E.

CHAINS

22.60 Mullen Canyon Trail Road, bears E. and W.; asc. 170 ft. over a S. slope.

30.60 Low spur, slopes SW.; desc. 40 ft. over a NW. slope.

32.60 Ravine, drains SW.; asc. 100 ft. over a SSE. slope.

40.43 Point for the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

81.17 The closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, on the S. bdy. of T. 35 N., R. 38 E., monumented with a limestone, 12x8x7 ins., firmly set and plainly mkd. as described in the official record, with a scattered mound of stone S. of cor.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
