

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, T. 34 N., R. 38 E.

Land, alluvial W. slope.
 Soil, rocky alluvial deposit.
 Undergrowth, sagebrush, budsage and shadscale.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 34 North, Range 38 East, MDM. is situated about 10 miles south of Winnemucca, Nevada. The eastern four tiers of sections are located on the west slope of the Sonoma Mountains and the western two tiers, on the east side of Grass Valley. The elevation varies from 4450 to 7650 ft. above sea level. Access to the area is provided by Grass Valley Road, improved gravel, traversing the township SSE. to NNW., and numerous supplementary trail roads.

Soil is generally sandy clay in the valley and sandy loam in the mountainous portion. There are cottonwood and aspen along small mountain streams and chokecherry along the bottom of high ravines. There are two wells, one in section 7 and another in section 29, they are used for irrigation and culinary water. Sonoma Creek flows perennially. There are numerous small springs in the mountainous area. No mineral deposits of significance were noted. There are two families living at the Sonoma Ranch, farming and cattle-raising.
