From the cor. of T. 35 N., Rs. 38 and 39 E.

N. 0° 25' W., along the W. bdy., of sec. 31.

Over mountainous land, through medium undergrowth and
scattered juniper; asc. 1,110 ft. over S. slope.

32.60 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 240 ft. over NW. slope.

39.78 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, at proportionate
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original
corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap,
4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

40.42 The closing cor. of secs. 25 and 36, T. 35 N., R. 38 E.,
hereinafter described.

41.07 The cor. of secs. 30 and 31, monumented with a basalt
stone, 8 x 10 x 14 ins., buried in the sod and plainly
mkd. 5 notches on the N. face and 1 notch on the S. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to
cap, 3 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
