| 32.50 | Trail road, bears SW. and NE. 2.00 chs. dist. to junction, thence SSE. and NNW.; desc. 50 ft. over N. slope. |
| 40.62 | The $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a squared wooden post, 2x2x12 ins. long, loosely set in a mound of earth. |

| | Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. |

| | reset the original wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. |

| 1.20 | Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains NW. |
| 2.00 | Trail road, bears SSE. and NNW.; desc. 40 ft. over gently rolling NW. slope. |
| 19.45 | Fence, bears E. and W., 67 lks. to fence cor., thence N. and W.; enter cultivated field. |
| 31.80 | Unimproved road, bears E. and W. |
| 32.00 | Fence corner, bears West, 0.22 chs. dist., from which fences bear N., E., S. and W. |
| 32.20 | Harmony Creek, 40 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep, course NW.; asc. 30 ft. over gradual SW. slope. |
