	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>A considerable variety of land and soil are found in Township 36 North, Range 38 East. The elevation varies from about 4300 to 6800 ft. above sea level. Winnemucca Mountain extends into secs. 6, 7, and 18. The southeastern portion of the township is rolling and the central portion is gently rolling to nearly level. The soil along the Humboldt River is silty loam; the remainder of the township is sandy to sandy clay. The vegetation on the upland consists of sagebrush, greasewood, cheat grass and areas of reseeded crested wheat. The bottom land consists of meadows with native grasses and cultivated land with willows along the river. There is no timber.</p>
