<p>Over mountainous land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 30 ft. over a N. slope.</p>	
3.60	<p>Wash, 30 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains ESE.; asc. 20 ft. over a S. slope.</p>
11.10	<p>Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 140 ft. over a S. slope.</p>
