CHAINS 40.22	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, monumented with a wooden post, 1x1x30 ins. long, loosely set in a mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T40N R33E</div><div><div><div>$\frac{1}{2}$</div></div><div>S 4 S 3</div></div></div> <p>1965</p> <p>reset the original wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 1° 05' E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land.</p> <p>0.90 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.</p> <p>19.10 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains ENE.</p> <p>40.12 Intersect the Eighth Standard Parallel North.</p> <p>Point for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T41N R33E</div><div><div>S 34</div><div>S 4 S 3</div></div><div>CC</div><div>T40N R33E</div></div> <p>1965</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>From the point of intersection, the standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 41 N., R. 33 E., bears N. 89° 57' W., 5.63 chs. dist.</p> <p>Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy loam. Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood and budsage.</p> <hr/> <p>The point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3 is on the Eighth Standard Parallel North and at midpoint on the N.</p>
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
