

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF T. 40 N., R. 33 E.

## CHAINS

Land, rolling.  
Soil, sandy loam.  
Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood and budsage.

N. 1° 19' E., bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 50 ft. over a rolling E. slope to cor.

28.40 Wash, 50 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.

39.27 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Descend 20 ft. over a NE. slope.

78.87 The closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, on the Eighth Standard Parallel North, monumented with the remains of a wooden post, loosely set in a mound of earth.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
