CHAINS

Undergrowth, greasewood and shadscale.

The point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5, on the Eighth Standard Parallel North and at midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 5.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The soil is sandy loam and rocky on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood, budsage
