## CHAINS

- 74.00 Divide, bears WSW. and ENE.; desc. 20 ft. along a W. slope.
- 80.23 Intersect the Ninth Standard Parallel North.
- Point for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone to cap, 3 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

- Corner is along an E. and W. fence.
- From this cor. the standard ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 34 bears S. 89° 59' E., 17.85 chs. distance.
- Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky and sandy loam.  
Undergrowth, wild berry bushes and native grasses.
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- The point for the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 3 on the Ninth Standard Parallel North, and at mid-point on the N. bdy. of sec. 3.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

- From this corner, the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35 bears EAST, 17.67 chs. distance.
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- From the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 on S. bdy. of the Tp.  
N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 32 and 33.
- Asc. 130 ft. over a mountainous SE. slope, through medium undergrowth.
- 9.30 Spur, slopes SW. desc. 170 ft. over a NW. slope.
- 23.00 Ravine, drains W.; thence over a rolling W. slope.
- 39.40 Small Creek, course W.; asc. 200 ft. over a SW. slope.
