	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The township lies mostly in the Tickaboo Valley; the western portion is in the foot hills of the Groom Range.</p> <p>The soil varies from a shallow clay with rocky outcroppings to a sandy loam.</p> <p>The vegetation is greasewood, shadscale, Joshua trees and scattered bunch grass.</p> <p>Access into the area is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 25 and desert roads.</p> <p>The principal use of the township is grazing for cattle.</p> <p>There are no settlements in the township.</p> <p>No minerals were noted during the course of the survey.</p>
