CHAINS

The positions for the four corners of T. 7 S., R. 58 E., the cor. of Tps. 7 and 8 S., Rs. 56 and 57 E., the cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., Rs 57 and 58 E. and the ½ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, Tps. 5 and 6 S., R. 57 E. were determined by direct ties from U. S. C. & G. S. "WHITE SIDES" distance by Tellurometer and azimuth by T2 angles from the line to "TUNGSTEN". The cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., Rs. 56 and 57 E. was established WEST, 38.33 chains from the ½ sec. cor. The cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., Rs. 58 and 59 E was established by cardinal offsets from U. S. C. & G. S. "PAHRANAGAT". The cor. of Tps. 6 and 7 S., Rs. 56 and 57 E. was established by cardinal offsets from U. S. C. & G. S. "WHITE SIDES". Directions of the offsets were deflected from the lines to "WHITE SIDES" from "PAHRANAGAT" and to "BALD MOUNTAIN" from "WHITE SIDES". The distances were verified by triangulations.

These nine township corners were connected by random lines. All boundaries of the four townships, Tps. 6 and 7 S., Rs. 57 and 58 E., were found to be very close to cardinal and within a few links of the calculated distances. These field notes reflect adjustments of less than 1' in azimuth and less than 1 link per mile in distance.
