<p><b>CHAINS</b></p> <p>79.98</p>	<p>The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on the N. bdy., an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 6 S., R. 58 E.</p> <p>Land, rolling. Soil, sandy loam and gravel. Vegetation, greasewood and Joshua trees.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</b></p> <p>The township lies entirely within the Tikaboo Valley.</p> <p>The soil consists of a sandy loam with gravel, the east portion being rocky.</p> <p>Vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale, Joshua trees and scattered bunch grass.</p> <p>Principle use of the area is grazing for cattle.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by desert roads leading from Nevada State Highway No. 25.</p> <p>There are no settlements in the township.</p> <p>No minerals were noted during the course of the survey.</p>
