

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, T. 39 N., R. 40 E.

CHAINS

raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

N. 0° 05' W., beginning new measurement.

Over rolling land, draining W.

2.50 Small wash, drains WNW.

9.40 Small wash, drains WNW.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.

17.50 Low spur, slopes W.; desc. 30 ft. over NW. slope.

27.40 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains WSW.

28.30 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 40 N., R. 40 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
