

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, T. 39 N., R. 40 E.

CHAINS

- Thence bet. secs. 5 and 32, continuing measurement.
- 69.00 Junction of trail roads, bears E., ESE. and WNW.
- 72.00 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains WNW.
- 77.30 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains NW.
- 77.81 The NE. cor. of secs. 5, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, gently rolling.
Soil, sandy clay.
Undergrowth, sagebrush and budsage.

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 4 at the intersection of the N. and S. center line of sec. 4 and the S. bdy. of T. 40 N., R. 40 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Proportionate point for the Maxson $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, not remonumented, bears N. $0^{\circ} 06'$ E., 10.72 chs. dist.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, bears S. $0^{\circ} 06'$ W.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 33, T. 40 N., R. 40 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 40 E., executed under Group No. 421, bears S. $89^{\circ} 59'$ E., 3.37 chs. dist.

The cor. of secs. 32 and 33, T. 40 N., R. 40 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 40 E., executed under Group No. 421, bears N. $89^{\circ} 59'$ W., 36.86 chs. dist.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. $0^{\circ} 24'$ E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Along gently rolling W. slope, through medium undergrowth.
