<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p>		
<p>The lines resurveyed within Township 38 North, Range 41 East ranges from mountainous in the extreme eastern portion to rolling in the western portion. The elevation ranges from about 4900 to 6900 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay, loam and rocky on the mountainous portions. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage and sparse native grasses.</p> <p>The northern portion of the township drains northerly toward the Little Humboldt River. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by desert roads.</p>
