	<p>Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay and loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and budsage.</p>
	<p>N. 2° 25' E., bet. secs. 1 and 2.</p>
	<p>Over nearly level land, through dense undergrowth.</p>
39.82	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, monumented with a redwood post, 2 x 2 x 42 ins., dimly scribed and loosely set in a small mound of earth between the 2 original pits, the outlines of which are visible.</p>
	<p>At the corner point</p>
	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>

29.83	<p>The cor. of secs. 1 and 2, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 40 N.; R. 41 E., executed under Group No. 421.</p>
	<p>Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay and loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 38 N., R. 41 E., executed concurrently under this same group.</p>
	<p>N. 0° 08' E., bet. secs. 34 and 35.</p>
	<p>Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 20 ft. over gradual NW. slope.</p>
6.60	<p>Wash, 20 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains WNW.</p>
7.50	<p>Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains W. into last wash; desc. 80 ft. over gradual NW. slope.</p>
35.00	<p>Wash, 10 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains WNW.</p>
40.32	<p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p>
