<p>2.80</p> <p>7.80</p> <p>40.97</p>	<p>S. 89° 43' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p> <p>Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains NNE.</p> <p>Eden Creek, dry, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains irregularly NNE.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.</p> <p>Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay and loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush.</p>
<p>40.27</p>	<p>N. 2° 33' E., bet. secs. 3 and 4.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p> <p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, monumented with a redwood post, 2 x 2 x 44 ins., dimly scribed and loosely set in a small mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T39N R41E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 S 3 1966</p> <p>reset the redwood post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p>
<p>40.80</p>	<p>N. 3° 13' E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Asc. 40 ft. over gradual SE. slope.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 3 and 4, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 41 E., executed under Group No. 421.</p> <p>Land, nearly level to gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay and loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and budsage.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 38 N., R. 41 E., executed concurrently under this same group.</p>
