33.40	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.	
38.86	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., on an X on solid rock and in a mound of stone to top, 10 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.	
62.90	Wash, 30 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains WNW.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.	
68.10	Low spur, slopes W.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.	
77.72	Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 4 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, 6 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.	
8.50	Low spur, slopes W.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.	
18.00	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains WSW.; asc. 160 ft. over S. slope.	
37.60	Low ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.	
38.86	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
