The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 17 S., R. 51 E., executed concurrently under this same group.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy loam.

Vegetation, greasewood and shadscale.

N. 0° 46' E., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over level land, through scattered vegetation.

Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
