From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.  
of the Tp.

NORTH, bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through scattered undergrowth.

3.00 Power line, bears N.  $80\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., and S.  $80\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W.

20.00 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.

37.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains NE.

39.85 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at  
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence  
of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

dimly mkd. and loosely set in a mound of earth.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
