	N. 0° 45' E., along the W. bdy. of sec. 3. Over gently rolling land, through scattered timber and undergrowth; desc. 50 ft.
4.80	Cooper Canyon, wash in bottom, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains E.; asc. 50 ft. to spur.
7.50	Trail road, bears E. and W.
12.30	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains E.
14.00	Spur, slopes E.
16.10	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains E.
20.10	Trail road, bears E. and W.
37.46	The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 4, hereinafter described.
40.10	The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, monumented with a squared wooden post, 14 ins. long, 2 ins. square, dimly mkd. and loosely set in a mound of earth. This cor. now refers to sec. 3 only.
	At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
