CHAINS	<div>T11N R66E R67E S 12 S 7 1967 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</div> <div>80.70 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div>T11N R66E R67E S 1 S 6 S 12 S 7 1967 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. Land nearly level. Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and greasewood.</div> <div>N. 0° 31' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6. Over nearly level land, through scattering undergrowth. 40.35 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with the remains of a squared post, 1½x1½x18 ins., loosely set in the ground, with scribe marks dimly visible. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div>T11N R66E R67E S 1 S 6 1967 bury the squared post alongside the iron post, and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</div>
