## CHAINS

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Continue over nearly level land, through scattering undergrowth.

79.55 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

N. 0° 05' E., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over nearly level land, through scattering undergrowth.

40.81 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in Township 11 North, Range 67 East, is nearly level with a small portion in the north central part which is slightly rolling. The elevation ranges from about 5,700 ft. in the south portion to 5,900 ft. above sea level on the east boundary of the township.
