30.50	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SW.
40.19	<p>The cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with a squared wooden post, 2 ins. square, 8 ins. long, loosely set in a mound of stone, with scribe marks dimly visible but illegible.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div data-bbox="751 749 917 876" style="text-align: center;"> <p>T12N R67E R68E S 1 S 12 </p> </div> <p>1967</p> <p>reset the remains of the squared wooden post and set a steel fence post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.</p>
