Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent dependent resurvey of the North Boundary of T. 11 N., R. 67 E., executed under this same Group.</p> <p>N. 0° 22' W., bet secs. 33 and 34.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through scattered undergrowth.</p> <p>3.80 Trail road, bears E. and W.</p> <p>20.00 Road, bladed, bears NNE. and SSW.</p> <p>28.40 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.</p> <p>39.68 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
