40.21	<p>N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 3 and 4.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through scattered undergrowth.</p> <p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T12N R67E</p> <p>$\frac{1}{4}$</p> <p>S 4 S 3</p> <p>1967</p> </div> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>Continue over nearly level land, through scattered undergrowth.</p>
