

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF T. 26 N., R. 64 E.

CHAINS

- 80.69 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.
Land, gently rolling.
Soil, light gravel and sandy loam.
Undergrowth, sagebrush and native grasses.
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- N. 0° 29' W., bet. secs. 4 and 5.
Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.
- 34.50 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.
- 40.60 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- 53.00 Trail road, bears NW. and SE.
- 80.87 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same group.
Land, gently rolling.
Soil, light gravel and sandy loam.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.
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- From the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.
N. 0° 24' W., bet. secs. 31 and 32.
Over mountainous land, through medium timber; ascend 400 ft. over a S. slope.
- 14.50 Spur, slopes E.; descend 240 ft. over a NE. slope.
- 22.00 Ravine, drains SE.; ascend 370 ft. over a S. slope.
- 33.00 Spur, slopes E.; descend 280 ft. over a N. slope.
- 40.49 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
