Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

- 51.00 Enter medium dense timber; asc. 710 ft. over an E. slope, changing to a N. slope.
- 80.53 The cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 63 and 64 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 26 N., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.
- Land, rolling to rolling mountainous.
Soil, sandy gravel and rocky.
Timber, juniper and pinon pine, western part.
Undergrowth, sagebrush and native grasses, eastern part.

N. 1° 09' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Desc. over rolling mountainous land, through medium dense timber.

- 7.00 Draw, drains ENE.; asc. 90 ft. over a SE. slope.
- 14.50 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 210 ft. over a NE. slope.
- 31.50 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 130 ft. over a NE. slope.
- 41.50 Head of draw, drains E.; asc. along a gentle E. slope.
- 42.22 Point for the ½ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
